6. ABSTRACT

The abstract is a concise description of the specific purpose, content, methodology, results, and importance of the proposed presentation. You must submit either a program/strategy or research abstract, in 500 words or less.

Program/strategy abstract criteria:

- Background/purpose of the service delivery program/strategy.
- Goals, objectives, aims or hypothesis, and outcomes.
- Interest to the juvenile justice, delinquency prevention, and victimization communities.

Research abstract criteria:

- Purpose of the research is clearly defined.
- Research design is clearly described.
- Innovative research identifies a gap or need in the juvenile justice, delinquency prevention, and/or victimization systems.
- Nature and scope of the problem are described.
- Data show that the problem exists.
