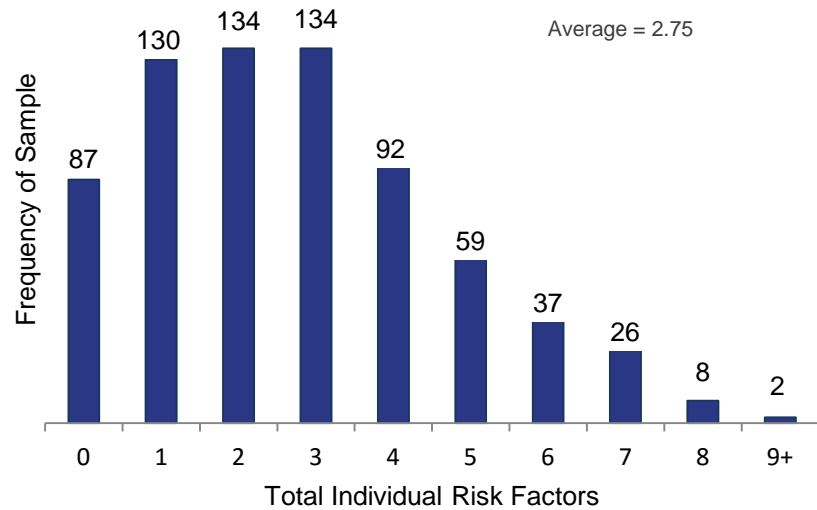
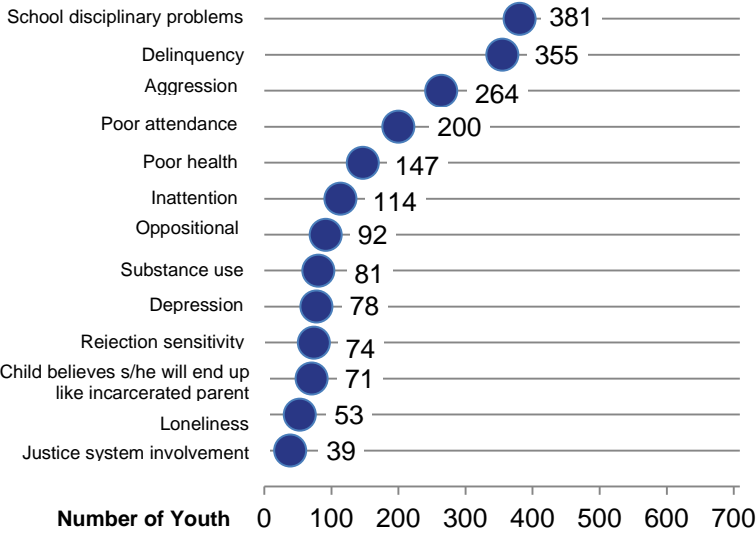


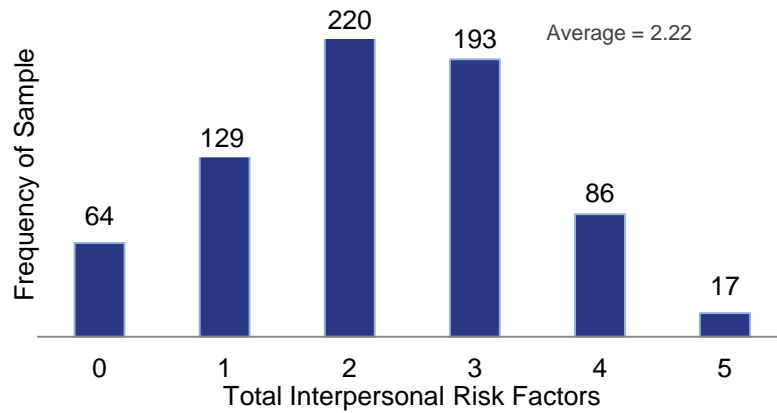
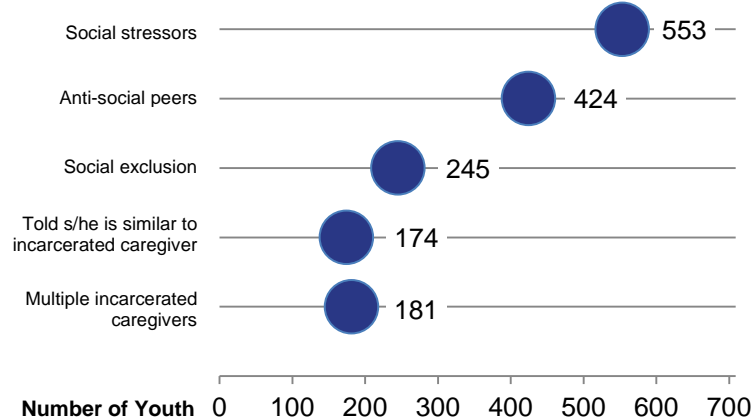
Mentoring Children of Incarcerated Parents Demonstration Project

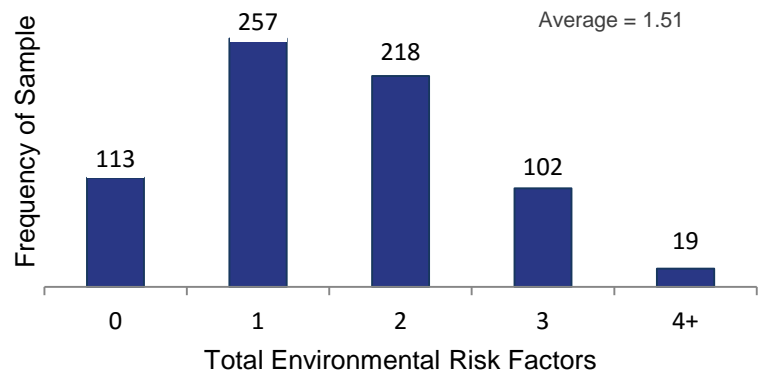
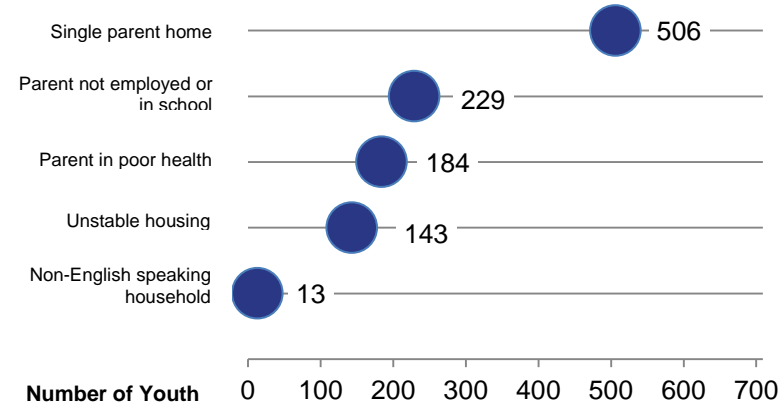
Individual Risk Factors
