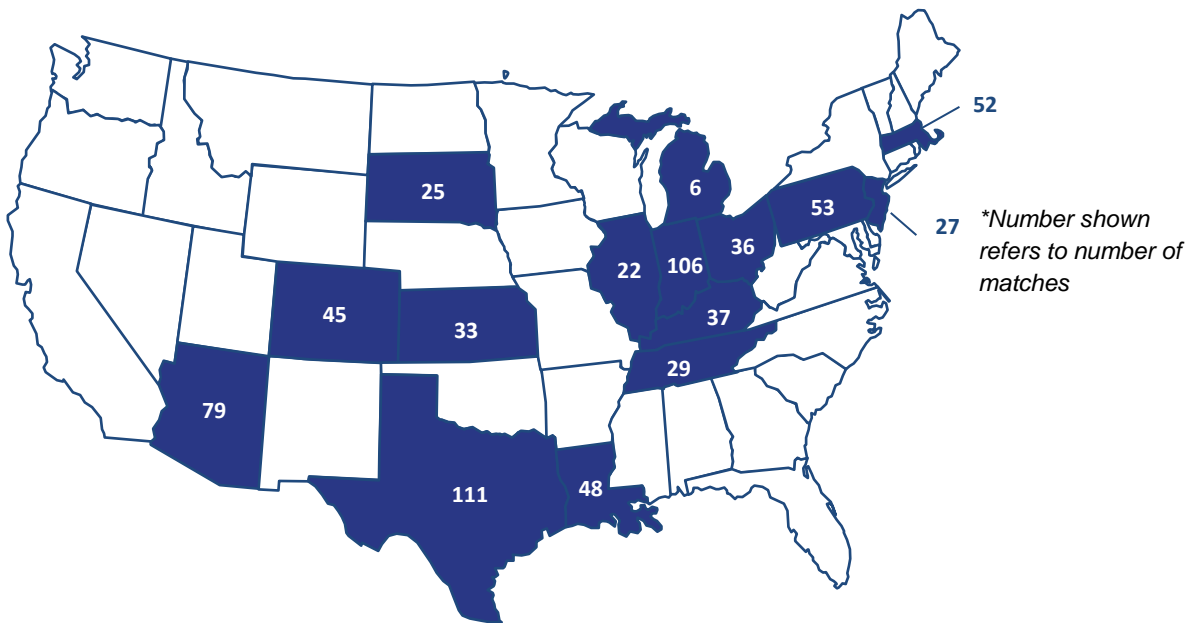

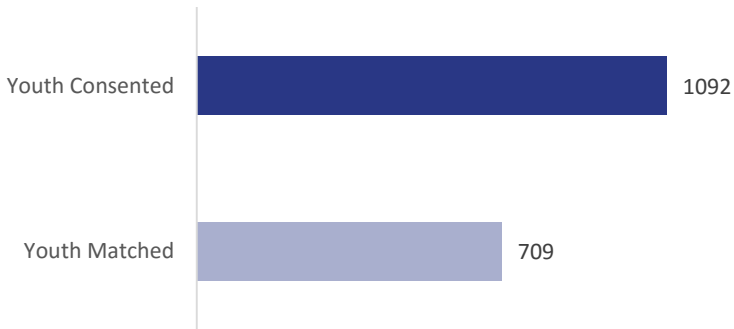
States Served

709 matches in 20 programs are being served across 15 states, as part of the project.

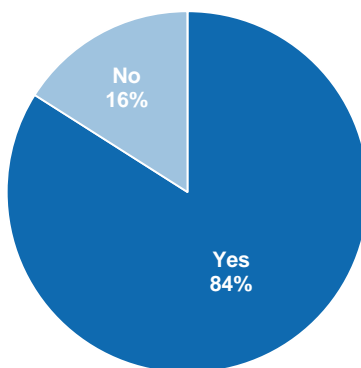


Mentee Recruitment & Enrollment

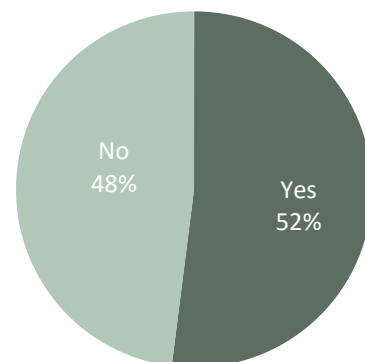
Recruitment goal: 1440 consented and matched youth.



Parent Consent Rate

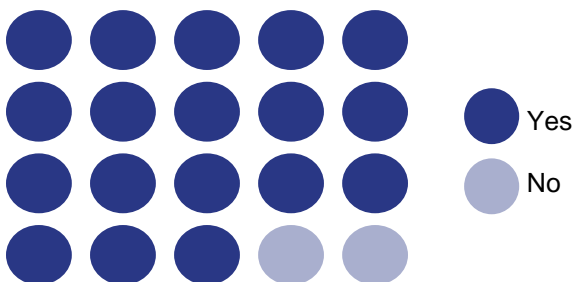


Mentor Consent Rate



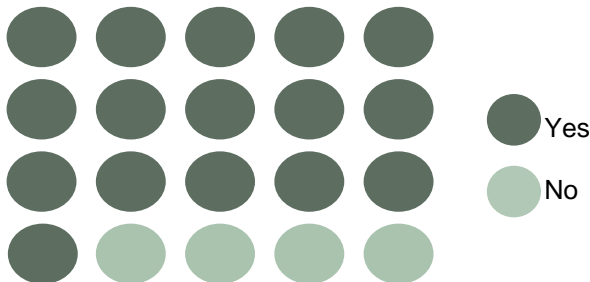
Program Implementation
